# From the Stampede Office:


Time is flying by, as the 98th Annual Greeley Stampede is

The Committee has identified safety as one of our top priorities this event. Our Red Shirt security team does a great job, but unfortunately, issues at other large events have caused us to make changes to be proactive. We will continue to work closely with the Greeley Police Department, Weld County Sheriff's Office and other first responders to prepare and implement safety procedures and awareness protocols to continue to make the Greeley Stampede a safe event for our volunteers, guests and staff.

Here is information about three new security changes:

In November, the Committee adopted a Stampede Arena Clear Bag Policy (see attachment for details). This policy is very similar to the Denver Broncos, CSU Rams and other large event policies. Our marketing team has a plan to share the details of this new policy with our guests. We will have complimentary generic plastic bags available at the park admission gates and clear bags will be available for purchase at our merchandise trailer. Volunteers will also have to follow

There will be more formal park entrances at the 11th & 14th Avenue entrances. We are also moving the park admission building that was located by the southwest corner of the Events Center to between the Events



Center and the Exhibition building. All park admission bag checks will now be conducted by a hired security company. We are also changing our Guest Information program by moving carts to the park entrances to help answer guest questions as they enter the park.

We are installing temporary stock panels to create an alleyway from the livestock pens by the Wrangler Hideout to the arena bucking chute pens. The alley will have gates to allow access east and west when they are not running stock. This change will greatly reduce the semi stock trailer traffic, be less stressful on the rodeo stock and help secure this area of the park from the general public.


# News in the Spur & Buckle Club

PROHIBITED BAGS INCLUDE: ALL NON-CLEAR BAGS LARGER THAN 6.5" X 3" X 4.5" CLEAR BAGS THAT ARE LARGER THAN 12" X 6" X 12", COLOR TINTED, OR MESH BAGS. (SEE THE PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST FOR A COMPLETE LIST OF ITEMS NOT ALLOWED AT THE GREELEY STAMPEDE)

#### **EXCEPTIONS**

DIAPER BAGS SMALLER THAN 24"x15"x18" ARE PERMITTED, BUT MUST ACCOMPANY CHILD AND ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH.

MEDICALLY NECESSARY ITEMS. THAT DO NOT FIT INTO A 6.5"x3"x4.5" CLUTCH BAG. **EXCEPTIONS ARE SUBJECT TO** SEARCH.

#### PROHIBITED ITEM FOR THE SAFETY & SECURITY OF OUR GUESTS, THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT PERMITTED INTO THE EVENT.

- Gang clothing or symbols
- Selfie sticks
- Drones
- Bikes, skateboards, roller blades/skates and hover boards
- Pepper spray/mace
- Open carry firearms
- Knives with blades larger than 31/2 inches
- Laser pointers
- Strollers in the arena (designated stroller parking provided)
- Outside food and beverages (non-water), coolers, bottles or cans (Water must be in a 20oz or smaller factory sealed bottle)
- Professional camera/video equipment
- Filming with iPads/tablets
- · Go Pro-style cameras
- Non-service animals

- Unapproved promotional materials and signage
- Unapproved service and merchandise sales
- Non-clear bags larger than 4.5"x3"x6.5", clear bags larger than 12"x12", color tinted or mesh in the arena (see clear bag policy)
- Any other item deemed unacceptable by management

Smoking is not allowed within the Stampede arena. This includes, but is not limited to, cigarettes, vaping, and marijuana

Large bags, briefcases and backpacks are subject to search and seizure upon entry and at any other time while on the grounds.

Prohibited items will be confiscated immediately. The Greeley Stampede will not be liable for any damage, loss, or theft of prohibited items.
