2017 was a great year. More than 260,000 guests experienced the 96th Annual Greeley Stampede.

With the help of you, the Wranglers, we were able to accomplish some great things for our community last year including:

 $\cdot\,$ donated more than \$94,000 to the Stampede Foundation to support education in Weld County

 donated \$4,000 to Northern Colorado Honor Flight to help send veterans to Washington DC


Our Committee Chair, Jackie Lyman is the key to the Gold Spur success with her bubbly persona, beautiful smile and fantastic leadership skills.




Rodeo News:


Howdy Everyone;
