Here are some gardening tips from the award-winning garden designer. • Survey carefully: Before you start your garden design, it is very important to know your site first. Do not buy any plants until you have worked out the structure of your outdoor areas and understand sun directions.

• Know your soil: Many gardeners

tend not to spend enough money on soil preparation. You don't need to dig through the soil endlessly – instead, a good rule of them is for every plant you purchase, buy at least two bags of compost. Investing in your soil at the start will save you money over time.



● Plant selection: Do not buy any plant, until you understand it. Do your research first to make sure that what you are planning to plant will behave as you expect. You need to be sure the plant will suit your conditions – the level of sun and shade, whether it's wet, dry or coastal and so on. Consider the size and shape that it will eventually become, whether it's evergreen or deciduous, and research how susceptible it is to pests and diseases.

• Avoid mixing the plants: In the excitement of owning a new garden, new gardeners often buy mix and match plants and end up with a large number of wildly different plant choices, many of them unsuitable for the situation.

Avoid planting trees near

the house: Before you start your design or plant any tree in your garden, make sure you select the right spot for the new tree to be planted. Roots may enter and block drains. If the drain leaks, it can lead to the formation of cavities where water flows into the soil. Older drains with poor seals and rigid joints are most susceptible. Branches can cause damage to roofs and guttering. Suckers and expanding roots can lift paving and lightweight structures, such as garages and sheds. Tree roots are unlikely to directly penetrate sound footings. Tree roots will proliferate where water is available, and this is what causes them to grow into drains. If the drains are watertight, then tree roots will

not generally trouble them.

• Add a water feature: From a modest, informal pond to the most elaborate formal fountain, a well-placed a water feature creates drama and interest in any style of garden. Captivating to watch, cool to touch and soothing to the ear, water has the power to transform and add that mesmerizing appeal to any garden. Whether it's used as the focus in a new garden or to add an exciting, fresh dimension to an existing garden, water offers a unique point of difference to the outdoors. With so many ways to integrate water into your backyard, you are limited only by your imagination. From simple natural ponds and meandering streams to elaborate features and fountains, water can be used in the end.

as a design feature in many ways. Incorporating a water feature into your garden requires a little thought and planning. First, you need to consider what effect you would like to create in your garden using water. Do you like the sound of moving, splashing water or the simple reflective qualities of still water? Once you have determined the effect you want to achieve, you can then choose the style of water feature that will create the feel you want.

Most catalog publications are free to view or download. Some are available in multiple formats.






