

INDIANA BRED

Indiana Bred is a promotional program established to recognize Indiana purebred seedstock producers while rewarding the 4-H exhibitors who showcase Hoosier bred livestock at the Indiana State Fair.

ELIGIBILITY

For animals to be eligible they must be Indiana bred and be registered by a national breed association to provide proof that animal was bred within the State of Indiana. Market Lambs and Meat Goats will be verified Indiana bred by origin indicated on USDA Scrapie Flock Certification Program (SFCP) tag.

INDIANA BRED SHOW FORMAT

During regular show classes for 4-H Beef, Dairy, Sheep, Swine, Dairy Goats & Boar Goat Does the highest placing animal entered in Indiana Bred within the regular class placing will be the Indiana Bred representative that will then show in a breed or division champion (meat goat does) Indiana Bred drive which immediately follow the regular breed/division champion drives.

INDIANA BRED ELIGIBLE SPECIES

- 4-H Beef Cattle
- 4-H Dairy Cattle
- 4-H Sheep
- 4-H Swine
- 4-H Dairy Goats
- 4-H Boer Goats

ENTRY & NOMINATION

- Register and/or nominate online at **ExhibitorsCorner.IndianaStateFair.com**
- Animals do not have to be individually ID'd online, the specific animal you want to show as Indiana Bred will be identified at on-site check-in at the fair.
- \$25 per head (**Exhibitor may register and Breeders may nominate**)

DEADLINE: ENTRIES MUST BE MADE BEFORE ARRIVAL/CHECK-IN AT THE FAIR.

Exhibitors showing in Indiana Bred will compete for:

- \$200 premium for Breed/Division Champions
- \$100 premium for Reserve Breed/Division Champions
