# INDIANA BRED

Indiana Bred is a promotional program established to recognize Indiana purebred seedstock producers while rewarding the 4-H exhibitors who showcase Hoosier bred livestock at the Indiana State Fair.

### ELIGIBILITY

For animals to be eligible they must be Indiana bred and be registered by a national breed association (no commercials/crossbreds or goat wethers) to provide proof that animal was bred within the State of Indiana. Market Lambs will be verified Indiana bred by origin indicated on USDA Scrapie Flock

Certification Program (SFCP) tag.

### INDIANA BRED SHOW FORMAT

During regular show classes for 4-H Beef, Dairy, Sheep, Swine, Dairy Goat Does & Boar Goat Does the highest placing animal entered in Indiana Bred within the regular class placing will be the Indiana Bred representative that will then show in a breed or division champion (meat goat does) Indiana Bred drive which immediately follow the regular breed/division champion drives.

- 4-H Dairy Cattle
- 4-H Sheep
- 4-H Swine
- 4-H Dairy Goats (Does)
- 4-H Boer Goats (Purebred & Percentage Does)
