What is the Jefferson County Fair Park?

The Jefferson County Fair Park is a premier regional event facility. Located in between the Madison and Milwaukee Metro markets, more than 200 events take place throughout the year with 300,000+ attendees of all ages.

- 15 buildings with over 130,000 square feet of indoor exhibit space
- Electricity in all buildings, running water in 11, 3 with heat
- Full food and beverage service capability
- 199 campsites on-site with electric, water and sewer facilities
- 10 acres of fenced parking, with additional 30 acres available
- 4,000 seat grandstand
- State of the art livestock boarding facilities
- 3 outdoor riding arenas and 1 indoor arena with spectator seating


We expect the Jefferson County Fair to continually upgrade concerts at the grandstand stage in the coming years.
