

2019 Jefferson County Fair Swine Show

1. This will be a terminal show
 - ONCE ANIMALS UNLOAD AT THE FAIRGROUNDS, THEY CAN NOT BE LOADED ONTO A PERSONAL TRAILER. ALL ANIMALS MUST GO TO SLAUGHTER.
2. The breeding stock & open class shows have been cancelled for 2019.
3. There are no state fair rights.
4. Exhibitors must make plans for their hog after slaughter (i.e. sell animal to a private buyer, process it for home use) prior to the start of fair. If you do not have a private buyer animals will be sent to market through another means and will ONLY receive current market price for those animals.
5. Exhibitors will be asked to notify the Fair office prior to Fair with the potential buyer information and processor. Additional information will be shared as it is available via E-mail and posted on JcFairPark.com
6. All pigs will show on Thursday July 11.
7. Please consider leaving all light-weight pigs at home. You will receive less money for pigs that are not finished out for market. If you have questions in regards to the weight of your animal please contact your 4-H/FFA project leader, or MAP rep.

OTHER TIPS

BEFORE THE FAIR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Coordinate Vet Check between June 17 – July 4 (CVIs are good for 30 days) - Bring completed CVI to the Fair. Proof of this is needed to unload animals. - Don't bring sick pigs to the Fair
DURING THE FAIR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Manage clothing and boots that are worn at the fair compared to at home. - Watch for swine wellness at the Fair - Pay attention to postings and announcements made by the Fair Office or MAP.
AFTER THE FAIR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Be present when loading pigs - Clean pens: No trash in Manure Pits. All decorations including tape & staples must be removed and properly disposed of. - Clean & disinfect clothing, shoes, vehicles, trailers, etc.
