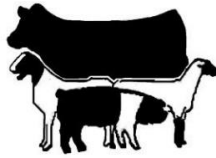

**Rules:**

1. Johnson county fair association will not be held responsible for any damage or loss of property.
2. No bedding allowed
3. Exhibitors must be 7 years old or 18 and under by Jan1, 2020. Showmanship JR-7-9yrs, Inter.10-13yrs, SR 14-18 yrs.
4. Animals in breeding are not allowed in market and visa verse.
5. Exhibitors will weigh their own animals. Weigh cards will be picked up at check in. ALL WEIGH CARDS MUST BE TURNED IN BY DESIGNATED TIME. Exhibitors are responsible to remember their weights.
6. The judge or show committee can request a re-weigh. A weight over the 5 percent of dedicated weight by exhibitor will result in disqualification.
7. Lambs will show slick shorn.
8. Market Goats must be clipped 3/8" or less. Breeding does may be shown with hair.
9. Beef show is Blow and Show.
10. ALL livestock no adhesives, paints, glue, or powder products.
11. All animals must be free from fungus, sore mouth, or lesions.
12. The show committee reserves the right to alter or combine classes.
13. Bucket calf exhibitors check in at fair office 12:00pm.  
Interview with the judge begins at 12:00pm  
Show after swine show. \$20.00 entry fee
