—Miranda Schack Chaplin is again the publisher of the *Green Book* for the horse shows. All information, however, will be sent to the KAFHS office (Somerset) by February 15. All horse show info (membership, class sheets, *Green Book* info and results) will be sent to the same address. Don't miss the deadline. Your inclusion is at no additional cost and is one of the best means of promotion you'll find. It is strongly advised that the information be sent digitally. Doing so removes all chance of errors on our part and streamlines the editing process.

—On the very first part of the application, you are asked to name "Person To Receive All Mail." This is exactly as stated and will be the one person we look to with any correspondence about horse shows, pageants, dues and all other information pertaining to your membership.

—In order to advertise that your horse show participates in the Association's High Point Awards Program and that you are a member of our Association, the appropriate fee must be paid. If you have more than one show, fees must be paid for the additional show. (A member can have up to two shows annually, but no more.) Individual and Family members attend our member shows in order to receive points and to qualify for county fair classes at the World's Championship Horse Show at the State Fair. At the conclusion of your show, you must forward a copy of the show program and the class sheet results to the Association.
