All teacher-entered school artwork will be displayed in the Education Center on the corner of Bison Boulevard and Lake Talbott Ave. Due to limited display space, **each student will only be allowed one entry** in their division. If the student wishes to enter additional artwork, they may do so individually in the Fine Arts Department, under Kreative Kids, with a deadline of August 15. ## Division 1 – School Arts - 2nd Grade and Under

To be mounted on construction paper or light-weight poster board. These items cannot exceed 9" x 12". Should item exceed the size limitation, it will not be accepted. If accepted by oversight, it may later be disqualified and/or not judged or displayed.

## Division 2 – School Art - 3rd - 5th Grade

To be mounted on construction paper or light-weight poster board. These items cannot exceed 9" x 12". Should item exceed the size limitation, it will not be accepted. If accepted by oversight, it may later be disqualified and/or not judged or displayed.

## Division 3 – School Art - 6th - 8th

To be mounted on construction paper or light-weight poster board. These items cannot exceed 9" x 12". Should item exceed the size limitation, it will not be accepted. If accepted by oversight, it may later be disqualified and/or not judged or displayed.

\*You may submit your item on canvas (no raw edges & must be ready to hang). Items cannot exceed 9" x 12". \*NO EXCEPTIONS

## Division 4 – School Art - 9th - 12th Grade

Frames and Stretchers Only - Not to exceed 30" including frame. Must have wire or eyes for hanging. Do not use nailed-on hangers or masking tape. No single mats or heavy pieces.

Stretcher canvas edges must be finished, with no raw edges. Canvas boards may also be framed. Entries can be matted within a frame.

## ADDITIONAL RULES/INFORMATION - READ CAREFULLY

1. **Any item that does not meet the requirements will not be accepted. If item is accepted as an oversight, it may later be disqualified and/or not judged or displayed.**
2. Subject matter must be original and not copies. Entries must be the work of the exhibitor with work being done since the 2019 State Fair.
3. Art work in frames, on stretchers, or canvas must have wire or eyes for hanging. Do not use nailed-on hangers or masking tape - Classes in Divisions 3 and 4 only.
4. Our primary audience consists of family and youth. We reserve the right to reject any entry that may be considered objectionable by that audience.
5. All exhibits will receive the best care and protection in their surroundings. They are at all times subject to owner's risk and in no event will the department or the Education Center be responsible for any damage that may occur. All exhibits will be displayed at the discretion of the Education Department.
