RULES OF THE SHOW

Because of new Texas laws, we can no longer provide on-site testing for Texas Pullorum-Fowl Typhoid. Poultry exhibitors should contact William Glass at (512) 466-8235 by August , 2018 for testing prior to admission to the fair grounds. All poultry exhibitors are required to present test results at entry time.

ENTRY FEE: Chickens: \$3.00 per head, \$15.00 per pen;

1. Current health regulations will be followed.
2. Entry fee \$3.00 per head; \$15.00 per pen.
3. Pens must be entered as pens– singles as singles.
4. No singles can compete for pen prizes.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their animals throughout the show.

POULTRY CLASS DEFINITIONS

Standard Breed and Bantam Chickens

Cock: Male bird over 12 months of age

Cockrell: Male bird under 12 months of age

Hen: Female bird over 12 months of age

Pullet: Female bird under 12 months of age

Old Pen: One Cock and two hens of same variety

Young Pen: One cockerel/two pullets of same variety

RULES OF THE SHOW

1. There will be weight divisions: A minimum of 5 head to make a BREED class. If there are not 5 head per breed they will be put in appropriate classes of British, American, or European.
2. Steer must be sufficiently halter broke to be handled safely.
3. No adhesive except for on tailheads.
4. Stalling space is limited. There will be NO PREASSIGNED STALLS. Stalling will be on a first to arrive basis. When barn is full you will have to tie to your trailers. **No refund of fees.**
5. **NO HAY IN BARN**
6. All empty trailers must park in **Designated Area in an orderly fashion.**

All trailers not parked in designated area WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER EXPENSE
