• GENERAL RULES •

1. All Exhibitors must be 5 - 19 years old (21 for Heifer exhibitors)
2. Showmanship age as of 1/1/18 determines age for class.
3. Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
4. Shavings ONLY - no straw. Exhibitors will be responsible for removing their own bedding after the show to the designated dumping areas. Failure to do so will cost you \$40 per head. Shavings will be available for purchase on grounds starting Friday at 10am.
5. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by exhibitors is prohibited at all times.
6. Appropriate dress is required.
7. Same show schedules both Saturday and Sunday - different judges each show.
8. No dogs are allowed on the show grounds.
9. Policies and selection of judges rest solely with management.
10. If a class has fewer than three (3) entries, entries may be moved to the AOB class.
11. Grade Heifer Champion will not compete for Supreme Champion Female.
- 12. Registration papers are required at check-in for Registered Heifer Show. Papers must be checked in the show office by 8pm on Friday for both show days.**
13. All Animals shown in showmanship must be owned by the exhibitor and entered in a class by the exhibitor. No premiums offered.
