2019 GEM STATE STOCK SHOW ALPACA SHOW RULES

Class Rules

- Check in on Friday, May 17, 2019 by 8PM or Saturday morning before 9AM
- All animals must have a current Health Certificate from an accredited Vet if from out of State.
- Ethical treatment of animals: All animals are expected to be treated in an ethical and humane way. Failure to do so may cause the exhibitor and animal(s) to be disqualified.
- The judge’s decision is final.
- Ribbons will be awarded per class as follows: (1) 1st place-blue, (1) 2nd place-red, (1) 3rd place-white
- Yearling and two year old & older classes may be combined by age if the minimum class size of four is not met.
- Maximum class size is 11; classes of 12 or more will be split into classes of equal size divided by age and each class will receive placings.
- Heardmanship will be judged based on the handling of alpacas.
