- Ethical treatment of animals: All animals are expected to be treated in an ethical and humane way. Failure to do so may cause the exhibitor and animal(s) to be disqualified.
- Poultry testing is MANDATORY. Testing will be on May 6, 3-7PM at the fairgrounds.
- Bring your own water and food dishes.
- LIMIT of 3 entries per division. If the barn is not full management will consider additional entries.
- The judge's decision is final.
