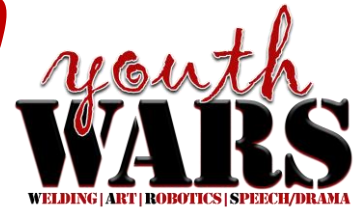

- Judging criteria
 - Speech- Articulation and Clarity, Confidence, Information, Professionalism, and Use of Aids.
 - Drama- Articulation and Clarity, Confidence, Creativity, Movement/Facial expressions, and Use of Props.
- All presentations must be appropriate for all ages. Inappropriate topics or language will **NOT** be acceptable and will be considered grounds for disqualification.

Speech presentations will be scheduled for Saturday, May 18.

Drama presentations will be scheduled for Sunday, May 19.
