### GENERAL SHOW RULES

-All exhibitors will sign a registration form; 18 & under must have parent's signature.

-All animals must have a current Health Certificate from an accredited Vet if from out of State.

-Jackpot awards will be mailed within two weeks after the show.

### Showmanship Contest

There will be a showmanship contest held for each species (see calendar or class lists for times). The showmanship contest is an additional \$10.00 fee. The Divisions are by Age as of January 1, 2019: Pee-Wee (7 & under, and must be accompanied by a handler), Junior (8-10), Intermediate (11-13), and Senior (14-18).

### Generators and Wash Racks

- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide his/her own power for cooling and grooming their animals.
- There is a limited supply of water and wash rack facilities.
- It is the sole responsibility of the showman to remove bedding and trash from their area after the completion of their show. This includes straw, shavings, grooming products, wool/hair, and trash.

### Ethical Treatment of Animals

- All animals are expected to be treated in an ethical and humane way. Failure to do so may cause the exhibitor and animal(s) to be disqualified.
