COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- Entrants must be currently enrolled in grade 9-12, or homeschool equivalent.
- Live welds will be limited to 45 minutes per project: Individual-45 Min., Group-15 Min. per individual.
- Still exhibit entries should have been completed only by the entrant, and no earlier than June 1, 2018.

- Judging Criteria
 - Live welds: Individuals will be judged on creativity, overall quality of work, and use of materials. Groups will be judged by the same criteria as well as implementation of different techniques.
 - Still exhibits: Individuals will be judged on creativity, originality, technique and quality of work.
- Entries will not be accepted or returned by mail.
- All entries must stay on display the full run of the event.
- Show directors reserve the right to reject any work found objectionable.
- Although every precaution will be made to protect exhibits, the Kootenai County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for theft, loss, or damage to entries.
