Exit Jewella Avenue from I-20. Turn North. At Fair Street turn right. Stop at credentials office if you need additional passes (Passes that are ordered on entry form will be mailed after October 10).

ENTRIES CLOSE OCTOBER 10, 2019. All entries should be mailed to the State Fair of Louisiana.

Check or money order for entry fees must accompany application for entries. Entry Fee: \$3.00 per animal. Make checks payable to State Fair of Louisiana.

Entry fees will not be refunded unless cancellation is made in writing and received prior to closing entry date October 10, 2019.

SHOW RULES

1. This is a one day carrying cage show. All carriers must have a leak proof pan.

2. Classes will include Sr. Buck, Sr. Doe, Jr. Buck, & Jr. Doe for 4 classes with 6/8 Buck & Doe added for 6 class animals. There will be no variety classes.

3. Entry fee must be paid by October 10, 2019 entry deadline. Order gate and parking passes when you enter rabbits. Each exhibitor will receive one complimentary gate pass. Adult leader passes are \$10.00 each. Parking Pass fee is \$10.00. Each vehicle brought on the Fairgrounds must have a parking pass.

4. Animals showing signs of ear mite, snuffles, or any other disease will not be allowed to stay in the show are and will not be allowed to be shown.

5. All rabbits must be put on the show tables by a youth.

6. Parents are responsible for the actions of their children.

7. Neither the State Fair of Louisiana nor the show committee will be responsible for loss, damage, or injury to animals or exhibitors. All precautions will be taken for the safety of the animals and exhibitors.

8. Anyone not associated with the show (exhibiting, judging, working, etc.) will not be allowed to sell rabbits or wares on the show premises.

9. No breeding allowed on the show premises.

10. The show committee will furnish scales and these will be used to weigh all rabbits.

The registrar will be available to register your rabbits. You must provide current ARBA membership card and a full pedigree including weights. Fee for registration is \$6.00 per rabbit.

SHOWMANSHIP

\$3.00 Entry Fee Junior (ages 13 and under) and Senior (ages 14-18).

MEAT PEN RULES

Meat pens shall consist of three rabbits, all of the same breed and variety. Broken group meat pens must also be of the same variety. A meat pen does not necessarily have to come from the same litter. Age limit 10 weeks (70 days). Minimum weight 3 ½ pounds each. Maximum weight 5 ½ pounds each. All rabbits must be weighed in the presence of the judge.
