## State Fair of Louisiana Youth Egg Show 2019

## **Rules**

- 1. All exhibitors must be entered in the Junior Poultry Exhibition Bird show.
- 2. There is no entry fee for the youth egg show.
- 3. There shall be no identification marks on the eggs.
- 4. An entry is made up of three chicken eggs. The eggs are to be selected by the exhibitor.
- 5. The eggs must be from the exhibitor's flock.
- 6. There will be three egg color classes (pee-wee, small, medium, large, extra-large and jumbo eggs will compete against each other):
  - a. White eggs (cream or tinted eggs will exhibit in the all other color eggs classes)
  - b. Brown eggs
  - c. All other color eggs
- 7. An exhibitor may enter one exhibit in each color class.
- 8. Judging criteria:
  - a. Uniformity 25 points
  - b. Size and shape -20 points
  - c. Shell texture 10 points
  - d. Color 20 points
  - e. Cleanliness 25 points
- 9. Egg show exhibits are due to the poultry barn by 10:00 am on Saturday, October 26, 2019.
- 10. Once entered, all eggs become property of the State Fair of Louisiana. All eggs will be destroyed after judging and at the conclusion of the egg show.
- 11. Awards will be presented on Sunday, October 27, 2019 at 1:30 pm.
