**To be eligible to exhibit in the Prospect Lamb show exhibitors must not be more than twenty-one years of age. All exhibitors must show their own animal without assistance in the ring. (Exception: If an exhibitor has a physical handicap he or she must notify State Fair of Louisiana Livestock Management in writing prior to the show for assistance.)**

**NOTE: All sheep must have an official USDA Scrapie Tag and an identification ear tag to be eligible for exhibition at The State Fair of Louisiana.**

**To Guarantee stall space you must enter by October 16, 2019. After October 15, 2018 the State Fair has the right to refuse entry due to lack of stall space.**

Check or money order for entry fees must accompany application for entries. Entry Fee: \$20.00 per animal.  
Entry fees will not be refunded unless cancellation is made in writing and received prior to closing entry date, October 16, 2019.

**SPECIAL ATTENTION IS CALLED TO THE GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THE EXHIBIT OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY IN THIS DIVISION.**  
All rules, regulations, premium offerings, etc., appearing in this catalog are subject to correction in event of any printing errors that would tend to change the meaning or intent.

1. Prospect lambs can be Wether or Ewe lambs
2. Ewe lambs that are pregnant will be sifted.
3. Exhibitors are responsible for feed, care and management of animals.
4. Sanitary regulations for sheep apply to all sheep on the Fair Grounds.
5. Wether and Ewe lambs are eligible to show in the prospect Classes but, ewe lambs entered in the prospect Lamb classes cannot be entered to show in breeding classes.
6. All prospect Lambs must be entered in the name of one owner.

7. Prospect Lambs will be shown by weight only.
8. Lambs to be eligible to show must not be more than 120 lbs.
9. All prospect Lambs will be shown slick shorn. A maximum of seven days wool or wool no longer than 1/4 inch. Britches will not be allowed.
10. Prospect Lambs shown at the 2018 State Fair of Louisiana must have an identification tag.
11. Prospect lambs will be weighted between 12:00 p.m. and 3:00 PM on the official weigh day designated by the fair management. Official scales will be provided.

## **WHOLESOME ASSURANCE STATEMENT**

### **ATTENTION:**

The use by non-veterinarians\* of animal drugs or other substances in any manner other than in accord with the labeling approved by FDA is a violation of federal law.

\* NOTE: Abuse of the extra-label privilege by veterinarians is unethical and is subject to serious consequences such as license revocation.

Any food animal must not exceed FDA/EPA/USDA-established tolerances for any foreign substance (identified or unidentified) including drugs, pesticides, feed additives, or other chemicals.
