**NEW FORMAT AND RULES** The 2020 State Fair Quiz Bowl will be conducted via a virtual Kahoot! game using Team Mode and broadcast LIVE on the Louisiana 4-H Facebook and YouTube pages.

- Teams may consist of a minimum of one member with a maximum of five members from the same parish enrolled in 4-H or FFA.
  - There will be one division for all ages, and team sizes.
- Teams will compete using a single device connected to an internet connection logged into the Kahoot! webpage or Kahoot! smartphone application
  - If the team has more than two members those participants will need to be in the same location utilizing a single device to answer questions as a team.
- Teams will compete in a trivia style quiz bowl with a single 40 question round.
  - If after 40 questions if a tie-breaker game is required , a new tiebreaker game will consist of 20 questions with speed to answer each question factored in the score.
- The main contest round will consist of 40 questions consisting of the following:
  - Five questions - Beef Cattle
  - Five questions - Dairy (cattle and/or goats)
  - Five questions - Goats
  - Five questions - Sheep
  - Five questions - Poultry
  - Five questions - General Meat Science
  - Five questions - General Genetics
  - Five questions - General Nutrition
- If required the tiebreaker game will consist of 20 questions from any of the previously listed subject matter areas.
