Rules

1. It is mandatory that all participants read and thoroughly understand all the rules and regulations of this tournament. By signing this form you state that you understand “AND AGREE” with all rules, procedures, payout, etc.
2. These rules apply to all participants and any violation may warrant penalties and/or disqualification. Any protest must be received in writing by the Tournament Director within 10 minutes of the “Closing of the Scales.” However, the Director may act on violations even without a written protest from another participant. Contestants are obligated to report any and all infractions they see within a timely manner. All decisions of the Tournament Director will be final.
3. Contestants under the age of 18 years must have the written consent/permission of parent or guardian to participate in this event.
4. All state, federal and lake regulations must be obeyed.
5. All entrants are subject to a polygraph test. Failure to take or pass said test will warrant disqualification. There will be no consumption of alcohol prior to taking an exam and everyone is subject to being selected. Anyone who has failed a polygraph exam in connection with cheating will not be allowed to participate in this event.
6. All participants are expected and required to follow a high standard of courtesy and sportsmanship during this event and the weigh in. This includes respecting other anglers, both tournament and non-competitors. ***A Coast Guard approved PRD must be worn any time the big engine is in gear.*** All boats must meet U.S. Coast Guard standards and engine may not exceed maximum horse power ratings for that boat. Boats must have an operating kill switch and must be attached to the driver while the big motor is in gear.
7. ***Alcohol or drugs will not be allowed*** in angler’s possession during tournament hours. Prescription drugs are allowed.
8. During the tournament hours no contestants shall receive any information about fishing from a non-competitor. There will be no “hole sitting” allowed.
9. Boats must have an operating live well system and participants must make every effort to keep their catch alive. ***No more than 2 fish will be allowed in your live well at one time. No calling a dead fish.***
10. All fishing will be done with artificial lures (prepared pork allowed). Only one rod will be used at a time and no rod can measure 8 ft. or longer. No trolling with combustion engine and no fishing within 25 yards of any other tournament boat that was previously anchored with their troll motor out of the water.
11. There will be no off limits for this event.
12. Penalties: There will be a .5 (1/2) lb. penalty for each dead fish. There will be a 1 lb. penalty and loss of fish for any short or slot fish brought to the scales. Do not bring more than 2 fish per team to the weigh in.
13. You may fish any of the 9 designated lakes during this tournament and swapping lakes during tournament hours will be allowed.
14. Teams may launch at anytime the morning of the tournament and may proceed to their destination at any time as long as they use proper running lights, PFDs and obey all rules and laws.
15. First cast will be 30 minutes before legal sunrise and no fishing after 3:00 p.m. will be allowed. These times will be announced Friday night at the mandatory rules meeting.
16. Teams must be checked in at the designated gate at the Fair Grounds no later than 4:00 p.m. where they will proceed to the assigned parking lot. There they will bag their fish and proceed to the stage to be weighed.
17. Registration and rules meeting will be held in the Hirsch Coliseum in the Bayou Outdoors RV area. ***At least one member from each team must attend.***
18. Registration will start Friday at 5:00 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. Mandatory rules meeting (at least one member of each team must attend) will start at 6:31 p.m. promptly.

Payout will be based on number of entries.

There will be 1 place paid per 5 entries.

Example: 50 teams will pay 10 places, 100 Teams will pay 20 places.

After the regular payout an additional 20 teams will receive

\$100 each Bonus Bucks from Landers/Ram.

**Example: 100 teams will produce a payout of
40 places plus \$500 for Big Bass.**
