**Premiums to be paid for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place only in classes of 10 or smaller.**

Check or money order for entry fees must accompany applications for entries.  
Entry Fee \$30.00 per animal.

Entry fees will not be refunded unless cancellation is made in writing and received prior to closing entry date, September 7, 2019.

**SPECIAL ATTENTION IS CALLED TO THE GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THE EXHIBIT OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY IN THIS DIVISION.**

All rules, regulations, premium offerings, etc., appearing in this catalog are subject to correction in event of any printing errors that would tend to change the meaning or intent.

1. Heifers in this division will be judged as replacement dairy heifers that have not calved.
2. Commercial Dairy cows must have freshened at least once to qualify for the commercial cow class. There will only be one class regardless of breed type or number of lactations or weight.
3. To be eligible for this division a heifer must not be registered with a dairy breed association. These may be purebred grade dairy heifers or crossbred dairy heifers.
4. Possession date for commercial dairy heifers is July 10, 2019.
5. State Fair ear tags will be issued to the 4H Agent or FFA Advisor **only**. The 4H Agent or FFA Advisor will then issue the ear tags to the exhibitor. It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to tag their animal.
6. All heifers entered and shown must be polled or dehorned. No more than ½ inch scars or re-growth allowed.
7. **An exhibitor may show no more than three commercial animals. For example two commercial heifers and one commercial cow.**
8. Heifers will show by weight. They will be weighed only once on a official set of scales (no reweighs). Classes will be determined by the range of weights of heifers eligible for exhibition.
9. Commercial Dairy Heifers must weigh a minimum of 150 lbs. with no maximum
10. Champion and Reserve Champion exhibits will be selected from 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place individual class winners
11. Commercial Dairy Heifers may be shown in dairy showmanship classes along with registered exhibits.
12. A best Fitted Commercial Heifer class will be offered.
13. There will be a parish group competition for Commercial Dairy Heifers. A parish group will consist of four commercial dairy heifers, all from the same

parish, with at least two exhibitors represented. **All heifers must be validated. Commercial Dairy will compete with Registered Dairy for showmanship.**
