Premiums to be paid for 1st and 2nd place only in classes of 10 or smaller.

Exhibitors will be allowed to use oil base or show sheen on show cattle. No grooming products may be used such as paint, dyes, glue or adhesive.

Junior AOB Non-Brahman entering the makeup ring with evidence of paint, dye, glue or adhesive will be disqualified

ENTRIES CLOSE SEPTEMBER 7, 2019

Check or money order for entry fees must accompany application for entries. Entry Fee: \$30.00 per animal.

Entry fees will not be refunded unless cancellation is made in writing and received prior to closing entry date September 7, 2019.

Louisiana Beef Breed Associations may have Louisiana Bred Champions selected by the Judge if Association desires. The association will be responsible for all awards and premiums in the Louisiana Bred Division.

LOUISIANA-BRED — if animal is to be considered for Louisiana-Bred Champion or Louisiana-Bred Reserve Champion, all registration papers must be received in the State Fair of Louisiana Livestock office no later than October 1, 2019. The animal must be entered as Louisiana-Bred at time of entry.

All bulls must be secured with neck strap in addition to their halter while tied in stalls.

All bulls exhibited in this division must be shown with a nose lead.

SHOWMANSHIP

THE STATE FAIR WILL PROVIDE ARENA, MICROPHONE AND DESIGNATED TIME AS IN SCHEDULE OF EVENTS.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE STATE FAIR OF LOUISIANA. **THE SHOWMANSHIP JUDGE WILL BE ASK TO PLACE THE TOP FIVE IN EACH AGE GROUP**

SPECIAL RULES FOR JUNIOR AOB NON-BRAHMAN INFLUENCE

STATEMENT ON AOB DIVISION

Recommend that cattle currently entered in the AOB divisions be required to meet the minimum percentage required to show in their association national junior show (Purebred). If not, the required percentage then would only be allowed to show as commercial heifer. The AOB division should be for those breeds that are not large enough to have their own division and not for low percentage cattle that are not recognized at the association's national junior show.

All registered beef breeding animals must meet the percentage of blood to be considered purebred, or meet the minimum percentage accepted by the respective breed association in their association sponsored shows. Registration papers must be presented to the superintendent to verify that the animal meets the minimum percent required by that breed association.

PARISH GROUPS (Must have three parishes or more to have a parish group class)

1. Where there are one or more Parish Groups of beef animals exhibited from a Parish, only one premium will be paid and that to the group receiving the highest placing.
2. Parish groups will receive ribbons instead of premium money.

CLASS

1. Breeding Beef Parish Groups, consisting of 6 beef breeding of the same breed, all from one parish, with not more than 3 animals entered by any one 4-H Club member or FFA member.
