

Dairy Cattle Capers & Ice Cream Eating Contest

"Dairy Cattle Capers" (Best Dressed Cow contest) is a costume class for the heifer or cow as well as the exhibitor. The contest will be held during the State Fair of Louisiana on Friday, Nov. 1st at 6:00pm, in Show Arena B or outside the livestock barn on main stage if weather permits.

The following standards will be used for judging:

- a. Theme promoting dairying or dairy products - 35%
- b. Costumes of both the exhibitor and the animal - 35%
- c. Cleverness and originality of costume to theme - 20%
- d. Neatness and control of animal - 10%

Entries are open to youth exhibiting dairy animals at the show (with their parents' assistance if needed). Dairy animals used in the contest will be shown in one of the regular dairy classes of either the open show or junior show. More than one animal or exhibitor can constitute an entry in the contest. Entry forms will be available when dairy cattle arrive and check in with superintendent. Deadline for entries is 5:00pm the day of contest.

The purpose of this contest is to add a little fun to the hard work of showing dairy cattle and to spotlight and promote the dairy industry.
