Premiums to be paid for 1st and 2nd place only in classes of 10 or smaller.

Check or money order for entry fees must accompany application for entries. Entry Fee: \$30.00 per animal.

Entry fees will not be refunded unless cancellation is made in writing and received prior to closing entry date, September 7, 2019.

SPECIAL ATTENTION IS CALLED TO THE GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THE EXHIBIT OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY IN THIS DIVISION.

***Photocopy of the Dairy Project affidavit and registration certificate must be sent to the State Fair by August 1, 2019.**

DAIRY CATTLE:

1. All dairy animals must be registered with their respective breed association.
2. Registration certificates of each animal shall be submitted to the Superintendent of the show.
3. The show will rotate breeds by classes. For example: the first class will be Junior Calf HOLSTEIN, followed by Junior Calf Jersey, etc. After all the Grand Champions have been named, then the Best Fitted classes will be shown in the same breed order as the regular classes. Parish group will show next.

Dairy Parlor Procedures

MILKING TIMES — 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

EXCEPTIONS: Cows will be allowed to milk out after their respective shows.

SCHEDULE

1. Exhibitors will be taken on a first come basis when signing up for services.
2. The 4-H Club Agent or Vo-Ag Teacher will be responsible for registering their respective parish or chapter.
3. Open exhibitors will be responsible for making their own individual arrangements with the parlor manager.
4. Each cow will be allowed 10-15 minutes in the parlor.
5. A schedule of milking times will be posted outside the parlor after a sufficient number of cows have been registered.

OPB

Any purebred dairy animal registered with a recognized dairy association and meets the requirements set forth in the premium list. (Ayrshire, Shorthorn, Brown Swiss, etc.)

State Fair of Louisiana Banners will be presented to the following:

- Grand Champion OPB
- Reserve Grand Champion OPB
- Best Fitted OPB

PARISH GROUPS (Must have three parishes or more to have a parish group class)

1. Where there are one or more Parish Groups of dairy animals exhibited from a Parish, only one premium will be paid and that to the group receiving the highest placing.
2. Parish groups will receive ribbons instead of premium money.

CLASS

1. Breeding Beef Parish Groups, consisting of 6 beef breeding of the same breed, all from one parish, with not more than 3 animals entered by any one 4-H Club member or FFA member.
