

Entry & Stalling

1. All classes in this division open for competition ONLY to bonafide members of 4-H Clubs, FFA, and FHA in Louisiana who are eligible to participate only through the calendar years that they graduate from high school. Exception: Arts and Crafts.
2. ONLY ANIMALS OR ARTICLES OWNED BY ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL EXHIBITORS CAN BE ENTERED IN THIS DIVISION.
3. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE SUPERVISING AGENT OR TEACHER.
4. Because of limited space the livestock director reserves the right to limit space per exhibitor.
5. Entry fees do not dictate stall/pen spaces. Exhibitors will only receive proper space for each animal delivered to the State Fair of Louisiana, regardless of the number of entries made for the show.
6. Stalling - Animals entered in the Junior Show must be stalled in the Parish area set aside for that purpose.

It is ESSENTIAL that the HOME MAILING ADDRESS OF EACH INDIVIDUAL EXHIBITOR be printed or typed on each exhibit form. BREED ASSOCIATIONS WILL NOT PAY PREMIUMS UNLESS THE COMPLETE ADDRESS OF THE INDIVIDUAL EXHIBITOR IS GIVEN. Unless the parish 4-H agent or FFA Chapter Advisor specifically requests otherwise, all premium checks will be mailed directly to each individual exhibitor. **CAUTION: ALL PREMIUM CHECKS HAVE AN 60 DAY EXPIRATION AND ARE VOID BEYOND THE EXPIRATION AND WILL NOT BE REISSUED.**

ALL STALL, PENS AND EXHIBITORS PLACES MUST BE CLEANED BEFORE 8:00 A.M. EACH DAY AND REFUSE MATTER DISPOSED OF AS DIRECTED BY THE FAIR LIVESTOCK MANAGEMENT. FOR THOSE EXHIBITORS REFUSING TO KEEP THEIR STALLS, PENS AND/OR EXHIBITS CLEAN AND NEAT, THE MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO HAVE SAID STALL AND PENS PROPERLY CLEANED WITH THE COST TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE EXHIBITOR. SAID COST WILL BE COLLECTED FROM THE EXHIBITOR BEFORE RELEASE IS ISSUED.
