Entry fees will not be refunded unless cancellation is made in writing and received prior to closing entry date, September 7, 2019.

All rules, regulations, premium offerings, etc., appearing in this catalog are subject to correction in event of any printing errors that would tend to change the meaning or intent.

1. These swine must be correctly registered with their respective breed associations and certificates of registration must be available upon request by the superintendent. At such time as there are 15 or more individual animals representing a breed within the OPB Section, a separate classification will be considered for them the following year.
2. NO ANIMAL CAN BE SHOWN OR ENTERED IN BOTH THE MARKET SWINE AND SWINE BREEDING DIVISIONS.
3. No exhibitors shall show more than three gilts in one class.

The awards will be presented following the judging of the classes by the LPPA.

The following class schedule will be used for all breeds except the Commercial Gilt classes:

2. April gilt farrowed Apr. 1 to Apr. 30, 2019
3. March gilt farrowed Mar. 1 to Mar. 31, 2019
4. February gilt farrowed Feb. 1 to Feb. 28, 2019
5. Champion gilt
6. Reserve Champion gilt

Commercial Gilts

Possession date is August 10, 2019

All Commercial Gilt must be validated with State Fair ear tag and be DNA tested

State Fair ear tags and DNA kits will be issue to the 4-H Agent or FFA Advisor **ONLY**. The 4-H Agent or FFA Advisor will then issue the ear tags and DNA kits to the exhibitor. It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to tag their animal and pull a hair sample for DNA. It will also be the exhibitor's responsibility to mail the DNA sample and information card back to the State Fair. **State Fair will not except DNA samples and information cards after Aug. 10, 2019**

1. Gilts entered in the market division cannot show in the Commercial Gilt class.
2. Animals entered in the Commercial Gilt classes may be crossbred or grade gilts. Exhibitor will be allowed to show a maximum of three gilts.
3. Commercial Gilts will show by weight only
4. Commercial Gilts will be weighed once on official scale. Actual show weight will be taken at that time by livestock Superintendent.
5. Number of classes will be determined by number of animals entered.

PARISH GROUPS (Must have three parishes or more to have a parish group class)

1. Where there are one or more Parish Groups of breeding swine exhibited from a Parish, only one premium will be paid and that to the group receiving the highest placing.
2. Parish groups will receive ribbons instead of premium money.

CLASS

1. Breeding Swine Parish Groups, consisting of 6 breeding swine, all from one parish, with not more than 3 animals entered by any one 4-H Club member or FFA member.
