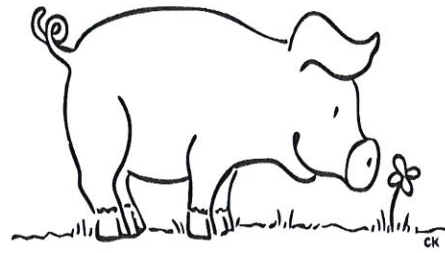


MARKET HOG



ARRIVAL TIME:	TBD – Connect with your leader or advisor. Tentative - August 1, 2020; 7:00 AM
JUDGING:	Tentative - August 1, 2020; 8:00 AM
REQUIREMENTS:	- Lake County Residents only. - Must be market ready & minimum of 220 lbs. - MUST BE SLAP branded UPON WEIGHT Two (2) photos are required and one video may be required for each hog.
ENTRY FEE:	\$16.00 per entry, per class
ENTRY LIMIT:	Combination of 2 market animals or meat pens – must be IDENTIFIED BY EAR TAG ON ENTRY

MARKET HOG SCORECARD:
GRADE
MARKET ACCEPTABLE: U.S. No. 1 and No. 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits.
PURPLE RIBBON – SELL
NOT MARKET ACCEPTABLE: Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. number 3, U.S. number 4 and utility grade hogs.
DOES NOT SELL AND WILL BE SENT HOME

RULES: SEE STATE & LOCAL RULES ALSO.

1. Market animals **MUST** show **BREED, NAME, SEX, BIRTH–DATE, CORRECT DIVISION AND CLASS.** (Cross Breed is determined by breed of Sire. Example: Hampshire Cross).
2. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor for 60 days prior to the opening day of the fair.
3. Watering arranged by Livestock Committee.
4. 2nd animal may be shown by substitute youth exhibitor for Market if youth has 2 Market animals in 1 class.
