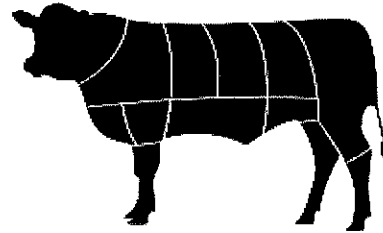


MARKET STEERS



PRE-WEIGH-IN	No pre-weigh-in for 2020. Your steer should be weighed by you or your club to know it will make weight. All steers will be weighed upon arrival and must make weight & grade to be sold.
ARRIVAL TIME:	TBD – Connect with your leader or advisor. Tentative - September 2, 2020; 08:00 AM
JUDGING:	Tentative - September 2, 2020; 09:00 AM
REQUIREMENTS:	- Lake County Residents only. - Must be market ready and 1000 lbs. - Two (2) photos are required and one video may be required for each steer.
ENTRY FEE:	\$16.00 per entry
ENTRY LIMIT:	Combination of 2 market animals or meat pens – must be IDENTIFIED BY EAR TAG ON ENTRY

- No horned market steers will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
- No out of control steers or steers that are a potential danger to fellow exhibitors will be allowed to be shown or sold. A committee shall decide if a steer cannot be entered for the Lake County Fair.
- No beef nose rings in the show ring, at weigh-in or during fair time are allowed.
- This is a terminal show and sale; no hold live permitted, Junior livestock to arrange transport & processing.

RULES: SEE STATE & LOCAL RULES ALSO.

- Market Steer must be owned by the exhibitor for 120 days prior to the opening day of the fair. Proof of ownership will be a brand inspection or Bill of Sale made out to the exhibitor, showing 120 days ownership, or a signed statement, and project record book, showing the animal was dropped from the exhibitor's cow and was raised by the exhibitor. Must include exhibitor's name and address. NOTE: Complete bill of sale must have sellers and buyers complete address. This must be presented to the Brand Inspector or Livestock Superintendent at weigh-in.
- It is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions that the quality standards established for Market Animals be maintained. Therefore, classification will be subject to change in the event there are changes made in Federal Grading.
- No **adhesive or glitter** to be placed on Market Animals
- Grooming Guidelines:
 - All market steers may be slick shorn to within 1/4" of growth (clipped against grain), shown with natural coat, or shown with fitted, blown Coat.

MARKET STEER SCORECARD

MARKET READY: Market steers projected to have sufficient fat deposition to meet the marbling specifications for USDA Prime, Choice, or Select+ quality grades.

PURPLE RIBBON – SELL

NOT MARKET READY: Market steers lacking evidence of sufficient fat deposition to produce a desirable consumer product. Steers projected to grade USDA Select- or lower.

- Proof of ownership, Brand Inspection, Livestock Transport "Yellow Slip".
- Fair Liability Waiver Form for each person.
- Copy of you YQCA Certificate
- Copy of Declaration of Medication Form
