### Matched Ranch Bronc Riding Rules

**Entries open June 15, 2019 & close June 30, 2019. Limited to 10 bronc riders.** Ranch Bronc Ride entries & \$200.00 fees will ONLY be taken on-line at [laramiecountyfair.com](http://laramiecountyfair.com) on PayPal with a credit/debit card.

1. Taking first 10 pre-paid entries
2. Eight second ride
3. No association saddles
4. No hobbling of stirrups
5. Will be ridden in working stock saddle with rope attached & loose buck rein
6. Can't switch rein hands during ride or drop rein.
7. Can use both hands.
8. Arena dress code: western dress, boots, hat, jeans, long sleeve shirt
9. Wildest ride on rankest horse wins
10. Rodeo will have one long go in two sections and a short go of the top five scores.
11. Will pay five places in the average
12. 100% payback with \$2,500 added & additional prizes

Rodeo will be at the Fairgrounds at Archer. East of Cheyenne off of I-80, Exit 370. Enter the complex & head south toward arenas. Follow the signs.

## Ten Minute Scramble

### Four Person Team

Calf Branding, Wild Cow Milking, Steer Doctoring, Trailer Loading



Entries open June 15, 2019 & close June 30, 2019. Limited to 10 teams. Team entry & \$400.00 fees will ONLY be taken on-line at [laramiecountyfair.com](http://laramiecountyfair.com) on PayPal with a credit/debit card.

1. Taking first 10 pre-paid entries
2. Cattle will be held behind a 60 foot line, cattle will all have matching numbers for each team. Each team will be drawn for number by staff.
3. Any cattle crossing the line that is not your team number or if your animal gets back across the line before task is completed will result in 30 second infraction per head. Ropes must be off cattle when returned to herd.
4. Any unnecessary roughness of livestock will result in a no time
5. All teams will be at the meeting prior to the Calcutta or they will be scratched. No exceptions, no refund of entry fees
6. Arena dress code rules western dress, boots, hat, jeans, long sleeve shirt
7. Winning team will be the fastest time
8. 100% payback plus an added purse of \$3,000.

**Calf Branding:** Calf will be headed & heeled & branded behind line, calf cannot cross line. Brand must be put on correctly & correct side

**Steer Doctoring:** One yearling will be cut out of herd, cross the line, headed & heeled & tied down & must stay down for 10 seconds or will have to be recaught & tied -any two or three legs. Yearling will be numbered on left side. Cattle must be returned to the herd upon completion.

**Cow Milking:** Cow will be cut out of herd, cross the line & roped "Catch as Catch Can", to be milked. Milk must be taken to the judge - there must be enough milk to pour out of bottle. If no milk, cow must be caught & remilked. Cow must be returned to the herd.

**Trailer Loading:** One yearling will be cut out of herd, cross the line, roped & loaded into trailer. No dragging. Yearling will be numbered on right side. Yearling will be gated then two horses will be loaded. Time will end when gate is latched & pin drops. If this is not your last event all the cattle are to be across the line and the pin redropped.

Rodeo will be at the Fairgrounds at Archer. East of Cheyenne off of I-80, Exit 370. Enter the complex & head south toward arenas. Follow the signs.
