

LATAH COUNTY FAIR COVID CONTRACT AND LIABILITY WAIVER

That Latah County Fair Board is dedicated to the health and safety of our exhibitors, volunteers, and staff. As we continue to navigate the current health crisis, we are committed to adhering to state, federal, and local regulations put in place to protect the community. We have developed a comprehensive COVID plan to guide the Livestock Show and Event and mitigate potential risks to our exhibitors. Please read and sign the policy below. This form is to be signed and returned to the Latah County Fair Office prior to any 4-H or FFA animal, exhibitor or attendee entering the barns.

All exhibitors and all household family members of exhibitors (“Attendees”) who are attending the 4-H & FFA Livestock Show, September 16th through 19th, at the Latah County Fair and Event Center agree to the following:

1. Attendees are not currently ill and within the last 72 hours have not:
 - a. Had a fever of 100 degrees or greater;
 - b. Had a persistent cough;
 - c. Experienced shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; and/or
 - d. Had symptoms of illness (e.g. chills, sore throat, headache).
2. Attendees have not had contact with someone who has COVID-19 or symptoms of an illness within the last 14 days.
3. Attendees agree to follow all City of Moscow ordinance and Latah County Fair Board policy which requires that face coverings (masks) be worn at all times while on the Fairgrounds campus.
 - a. Masks are required in all buildings, barns, wash racks, prep areas, playgrounds, and showrings
 - b. Masks are not required when household members are alone, in their private campsites/campers.
4. Attendees agree that their refusal to abide by the above COVID policies may result in the dismissal of the livestock exhibitor, their animal, and immediate family members in attendance.

Waiver/Release for Communicable Diseases Including Covid-19:

In consideration of being allowed to participate in the Latah County Livestock Show and Event, the undersigned acknowledge and agree that:

1. Despite Latah County following federal, state and local guidelines for COVID exposure reduction, participation may include possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases, including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and/or death may exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF LATAH COUNTY or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation as agreed to above; and
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS Latah County, their volunteers, officials, agents, and/or employees,

sponsoring agencies, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event (“RELEASEES”), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I HAVE READ THIS COVID CONTRACT AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.
