COVID-19 Response & Plan.

Revision: August 24, 2020

Physical Distancing will be practiced on all areas of the Fairgrounds and is defined as: keeping physical distancing of 6 feet or more, as recommended by CDC, between persons who are not from the same household.

Face Coverings are required while on the Fairgrounds: Patrons, 4-H and FFA exhibitors, exhibitor families, volunteers, vendors, and staff are asked to follow the city ordinance that face coverings (masks) are required at all times while on the Fairgrounds campus, during the Fair.

Private Weekend: This weekend is a private event, open only to exhibitors and their immediate households only. The general public and extended family members are not able to attend or be present on the Fairgrounds.

4-H General Exhibits in the Events Center:

1. General projects will be accepted in the Large Room of the Events Center on Wednesday, September 16th from 3-7pm. Please use the large door on the South wall to access the room.

Livestock Shows & Barns:

1. Animals will arrive Wednesday morning
2. Exhibitors will be asked to not gather in group gatherings at the scales, wash rack, or inside spaces
3. Livestock shows will be Thursday and Friday, Round Robin contests will be Saturday
4. During the swine shows, audience members are limited to spectators of current class
5. Small animals, lightweight market animals, and breeding projects may leave the grounds at the conclusion of their shows. Loud outs must be scheduled with a Superintendent.

Exhibitor RV Camping:

1. We will be putting more space between campers, and moving some of the campers from the ball field to north and south of the Ice Rink.

4-H and FFA Live Stock Auction:

The 4-H and FFA livestock auction is under the production control of the Latah Market Animal Sale Committee INC (LMAS). The 2020 4-H and FFA Livestock Auction will be a VIRTUAL AUCTION using the software program of ShoWorks. The LMAS Committee will be in the middle room of the Events Center during the livestock weekend.
