

Dear 2020 Latah County Livestock Exhibitors,

As many of you are aware, this year will be like no other year before. As we prepare for the Livestock Show, I would like to address some changes to this year's camper parking.

We will begin parking campers on Saturday, September 12, 2020 from 7:00 AM – 11:00 AM. Camper parking will be on a first come first serve basis, but you will be parked by community in your designated area. Late arrivals will only be accepted if prior arrangements have been made with our fair director, Jim Logan.

Check in will be the same. Turn off of Mountain View Road onto access road between the fire station and the ice rink. Travel west towards the stage and check in. All registered campers over 35 feet will go directly to the north side of the ice rink as normal. With the carnival not being here this year, we are going to utilize this space. Once you've checked in, we will direct you where to park.

Once campers are parked, NO VEHICLES will be allowed in the camp areas until after the Livestock Show is over.

Per the city of Moscow's mask ordinance, masks ARE REQUIRED if you are outside of the awning area of your camper, and/or if social distancing cannot be practiced in or around the awning area. Masks are not required in your awning area if social distancing can be practiced or it is your immediate family only.

No extended family is allowed in the camping areas at the fairgrounds. Registered immediate family only in the camping area and fairgrounds.
