**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER RESTRICTING PUBLIC ACCESS TO LATAH COUNTY
FACILITIES**

Prohibiting Events of More than 10 Persons at Buildings of Latah County Events Center

WHEREAS, the health and safety of all Latah County residents, patrons and employees is the greatest priority of the Board of Latah County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, there is a risk to life and the continued operation of public infrastructure as a result of the potential for cases of 2019 novel coronavirus (COVID-19) throughout the State of Idaho and Latah County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Latah County Commissioners issued an Order Restricting Public Access to Latah County Facilities on March 18, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Idaho adopted CDC guidance on March 18, 2020 which states that social gatherings of more than 10 people should be avoided; and

WHEREAS, while the majority of events with more than 10 persons have been canceled at the buildings of the Latah County Events Center, there remain scheduled events which would rise above the amount of persons authorized to gather together and would jeopardize the health and safety of the residents of Latah County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Latah County authorized the Chair's signature on this Order at meeting of the Board on March 19, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that public access to the Latah County Fairgrounds Event Center is hereby restricted as follows:


No events, gatherings or meetings of any kind shall be held at the buildings of the Latah County Events Center which may result in a gathering of more than 10 people at any time.

This Order shall not apply to use by any Latah County disaster and/or emergency services.


Signs communicating this restricted access shall be conspicuously posted at the Latah County Events Center.

This Order and shall be effective immediately upon its passage and shall remain in full force and effect until May 5, 2020, unless otherwise terminated or extended by the Board of County Commissioners.
