

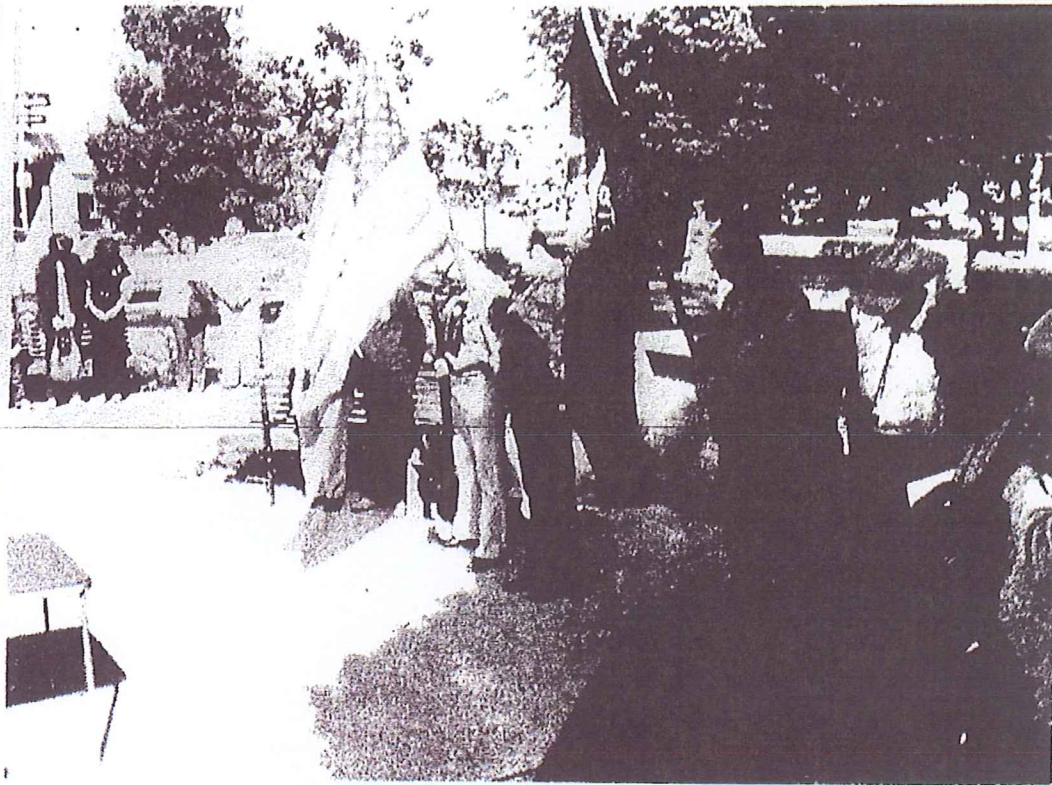

VIETNAM VETS REMEMBERED

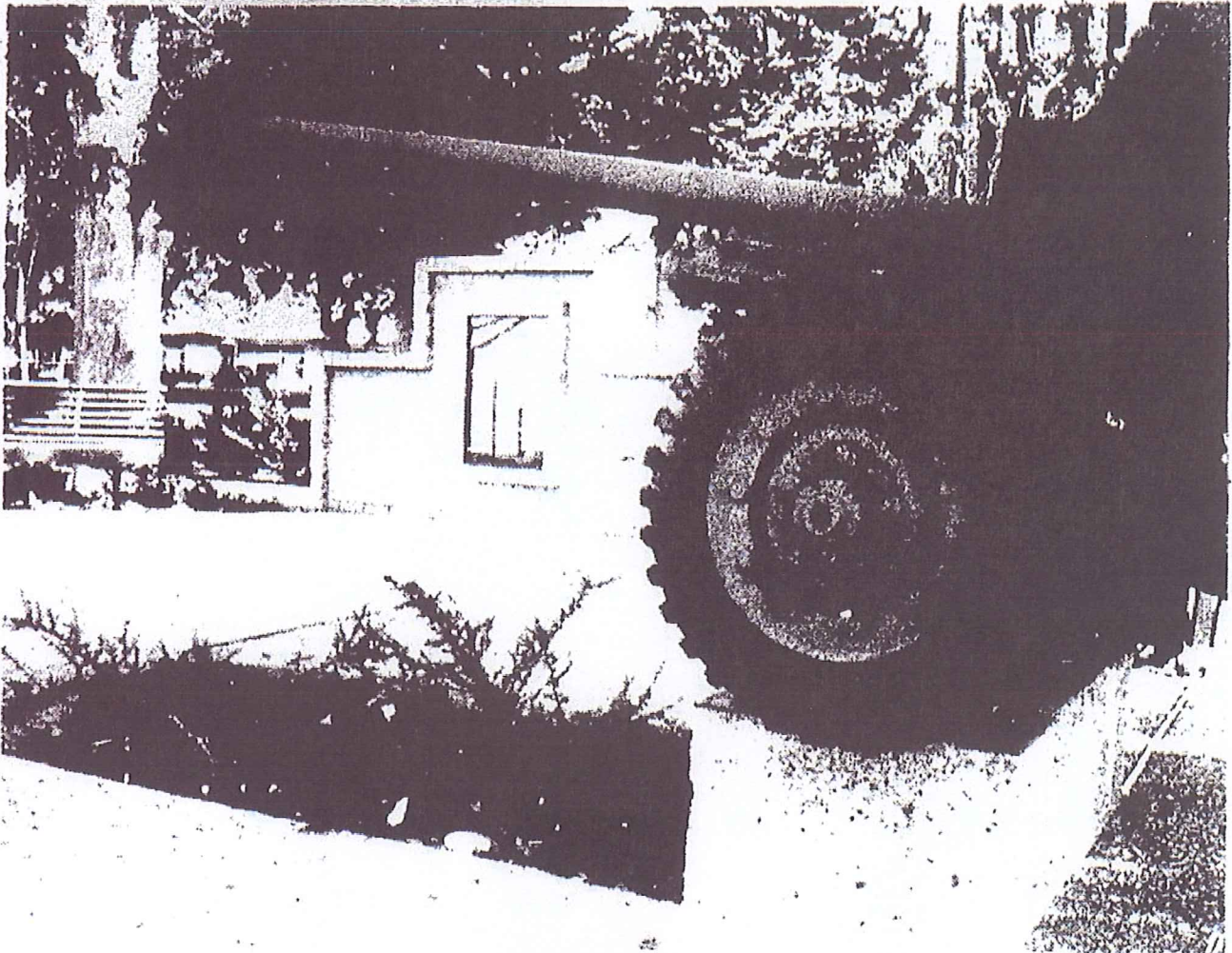
