**Commissioner Fulfer led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by the Invocation by Commissioner Long.**


**ITEM 01: OTHER ELECTED OFFICIALS**

  - Consideration of Approval of Lea County Resolution No. 16-JUN-092R Canvass of the June 7, 2016 Primary Election

Clerk Chappelle requested approval of the 2016 Primary Election Canvass. She thanked the Commission, all of the departments and offices of Lea County, and the election officials. Results were in by 9:00 p.m. and released to the public by 9:10 p.m. It is a County Wide effort, and we appreciate the assistance received from everyone. Clerk Chappelle explained the Canvass and gave statistics. The Democrats voted at 15% resulting in 1,479 Democrat voters, and the Republicans voted a little over 25% resulting in 4,078 Republican voters. Commissioner Long moved to approve Lea County Resolution No. 16-JUN-092R Canvass of the June 7, 2016 Primary Election. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Fulfer and passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:13 a.m.


