A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A FREEHOLDERS COMMITTEE TO EVALUATE THE VACATION OF
DEDICATED ALLEY IN BLOCK 4, OF THE MONUMENT HEIGHTS ADDITION IN THE TOWN OF
MONUMENT, NEW MEXICO

WHEREAS, Lea County received a request to vacate a dedicated alley in Monument Heights Addition, Block 4 in the town of Monument, New Mexico; *and*

WHEREAS, pursuant to NMSA 1978 § 67-5-4, the Lea County Board of County Commissioners must appoint a three person freeholds committee; *and*

WHEREAS, the three person freeholders' committee will evaluate and make a recommendation to the Lea County Board of County Commissioners at the next regular commission meeting setting forth their finding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County, that three freeholders be appointed to determine if the dedicated right of way should remain a dedicated right of way or be vacated and abandoned pursuant to NMSA 1978 § 67-5-4.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY LEA COUNTY that the three person freeholders are:

3. Lorenzo Velasquez, Director of Emergency Management


