Manufactured Homes as Permanent Residence:

(Per NM State Manufactured Home Regulations, 3.65.33)

Step 1. An inspection of the manufactured home foundation will need to be conducted, at which time the foundation <u>must</u> pass inspection.

Call the State of New Mexico in Santa Fe at 505-827-6175 and ask for the Manufactured Housing Division. (Tie Downs do not work). A New Mexico certified professional engineer's inspection will also be accepted.

- Step 2. Bring Permit or engineer's inspection to our office showing that the foundation passed inspection. A tax release on the mobile home will be done at this time and Request to Change Valuation Status filled out.
- Step 3. Tax Release, Change of Valuation form, and Original Certificate of Title is given to the Motor Vehicle Department to have the Title Deactivated.
- Step 4. Provide our office with a copy of the Deactivated Title.
- Step 5. Our Appraisal Department will have to do a field check to assess the property as a whole as "Real Property".

*Paperwork that the Lea County Assessor's Office needs:

- 1. Approval (Permit) from RDL System or engineer's inspection.
- 2. Copy of Deactivated Title
