Lea County Wins Budget Award

Lea County Courthouse, Lovington, NM: The Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) awarded **Lea County, New Mexico** the GFOA's Distinguished Budget Presentation Award for the 2014 budget. Lea County Manager Mike Gallagher said "this award is the highest form of recognition in governmental budgeting and represents a significant achievement by Lea County elected officials and staff. We consistently strive for a budget that is conservative and transparent."

Lea County Board of County Commissioners Chairman Gregg Fulfer comments "the award reflects the commitment of the governing body and staff to meet the highest principles of government budgeting." In order to receive the budget award, the entity had to satisfy nationally recognized guidelines for effective budget presentation. The guidelines assess how well an entity's budget serves as a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device. Budget documents must be rated "proficient" in all four categories and the fourteen mandatory criteria within those categories.
