PROGRAM RULES

You are currently under the supervision of the Lea County Misdemeanor Compliance Program and are ordered to follow the requirements listed below. You will be under supervision until you are officially discharged. You are to refrain from drug and alcohol use during your supervision period. **Periodically, you may be subject to random drug/alcohol testing. Evidence of alcohol or drug usage will be grounds for referral back to court.**

- 1. You are to notify your Compliance Officer if any personal or contact information changes within **24 HOURS**, including but not limited to: address, phone number(s), employment, emergency contact.
- 2. You will receive **ONE REMINDER** by your preferred method of contact in reference to your orientation appointment. If you fail to attend your scheduled orientation without proper notice, a Probation Violation will be forwarded to your sentencing court.
- 3. If you are planning to leave Lea County for a period of 24 hours or more, you must submit a travel permit request to your Compliance Officer within the time period designated on the travel permit request form. If travel is approved by Compliance Officer you will be given a travel permit prior to your leave date.
- 4. Clothing which portrays profanity, nude images, illegal activity, or drug/alcohol images are not allowed at **any** check-in, class, community service, or counseling session.
- 5. You are not allowed to carry **any** type of weapon and/or firearms on the Lea County premises.
- 6. **NO PERSONAL ITEMS ALLOWED passed Security**. Personal items will include backpacks, bags, purses, cell phones, keys, ipads/tablets, watches of any type. You may utilize provided lockers for items at your own risk. Lea County is NOT responsible for items left in lockers.
- 7. You are responsible for providing proof of completed sanctions to our office prior to the due date assigned by your Compliance Officer.
- 8. You are responsible for appearing on time for your appointments and/or classes.
- 9. You will conduct yourself in a respectful manner toward all staff, at all times.
- 10. Any violation of program rules will result in you being referred back to your sentencing court.
