- SET UP AND STRIKE VARIOUS AUDIOVISUAL EQUIPMENT AND COMPONENTS FOR EVENTS.
- OPERATE AND TROUBLESHOOT AUDIOVISUAL EQUIPMENT PRIOR TO AND DURING SCHEDULED EVENTS.
- ACT AS DEDICATED EVENT AUDIOVISUAL TECHNICIAN FOR EVENTS WHEN NEEDED.
- Adjusting and focusing theatrical lights, at height, for upcoming events.
- Perform routine maintenance and repairs of A/V equipment.
- Maintain inventory of equipment and consumables.
- Assistance in the set-up and strike of non-A/V equipment such as chairs, tables, dance floors, etc. Will be required.

REQUIRED SKILLS & ABILITIES:
