Rabbits Out: The shows are carrying case shows only. Tables will be available for each exhibitor to set up their rabbit on the day of **Show/Showmanship** after check-in. Rabbits will go home after their showmanship event.

Only meat pen rabbits and exhibition/educational rabbits will be housed in the barn this year for display.

RABBIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exhibitors must be a *bona fide* member of a Manatee County 4-H Specialty Club or FFA Chapter. No one who has graduated from High School will be eligible to show. All 4-H and FFA Exhibitors must attend a Manatee County Public School or reside in Manatee County. Home Schooled Exhibitors must live in Manatee County. ~~All Exhibitors at the Manatee County Fair must have completed one class of ethics training before being allowed to show. There will be an Ethics Training Class administered on October 19th at the Manatee County Fairgrounds. Exhibitors will be required to sign up for the class at the following site when it is available. <http://www.floridastatefairag.com/pdffiles/live-et...>~~

Due to Covid-19 Ethics classes will not be offered this year. With that said we are going suspend the Ethics Rule this year. All Exhibitors must still care for and treat all Animals ethically.

2. No exhibition of livestock by anyone less than 8 years of age (as of September 1) will be allowed. Exhibitor age as of September 1, 2020 will determine the class in which the exhibitor will show. (Juniors are age 8-10, Intermediates are ages 11-13, and seniors are ages 14 and up.)
3. **Initial check in will be on-line all livestock to be exhibited will have to be registered. Show/Showmanship will be Carrying Case Show, Check-in will occur the day of Show/Showmanship.** Exhibitor and animal must be together in order for animal to be checked in. A parent or legal guardian must be present to complete all required documentation that is needed, sale pens will need sales contract. The Manatee River Fair Board encourages parents to be involved in their child's 4-H and FFA Projects. A Notarized Exhibitor/Photo release form prepared by the Fair Association. Form must be emailed to ManateeCountyRabbit@manateecountyfair.com by **October 26**, 2020.

**** Exhibitors are not allowed to change animal exhibits after the initial check-in ****

4. There will be a **\$2.00 entry fee per Rabbit pen and a \$5.00 entry fee for meat sale pens.** Entry will be due with your **on line registration** on each entry. These funds will be used to cover a portion of the cost.
5. All exhibitors must be in good standing with their respective clubs to exhibit at the Manatee County Fair. All exhibitors will show in the 4-H Club or FFA Chapter in which they registered their livestock at their respective check-in event.
6. Each exhibitor assumes all liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal.
7. All exhibitors must be in their official 4-H and FFA dress, during the show as specified by their respective animal area.
8. No Substitute exhibitors are allowed unless there are extreme reasons and granted permission by the Manatee County Fair Livestock Committee.
9. All Exhibitors participating in their respective showmanship areas must utilize only the animal that they initially checked in under their name.
10. All record books must be up to date and checked in to the designated committee at time of final check-in at the Fair. An up to date record book is required on ALL animals that were registered at the initial check-in, whether that Animal made it to the fair or not. A committee of fair representatives will check in record books. **If your animal did not make the final check-in, your record book is still required to be e-mailed to**

ManateeCountyRabbit@manateecountyfair.com before the end of the fair in order to be eligible to show the next year in the Manatee County Fair.

11. All livestock health regulations must follow Florida State Guidelines and must be transported to the Manatee County Fair in accordance with those guidelines.
12. Use of drugs not in compliance with manufacturer's label as to dosage, time limitations and show regulations is prohibited. The use of any calming agents on animals during the Fair or the possession of same by a 4-H or FFA member or anyone assisting said member with his or her animal is prohibited. Violation of this provision shall disqualify the animal from competition and any awards or premiums, including sale price of animal, shall be forfeited.
13. All animals are subject to being examined and blood tested for any drug usage at any time. Refusal by the 4-H or FFA member to submit their animal to such examination or test will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of all premiums and awards, including sale price.
14. Upon disqualification, pursuant to Paragraphs No. 12 and 13 the affected animal shall immediately be removed from the Fairgrounds.
15. On-site inspections of any livestock may be made by authorized agents of the Manatee River Fair Association at any time, after first check-in or before Fair.
16. **Application Registration: All applications must be complete.** No rabbits under 3 months of age at time of application. Exception: **Rabbit Meat Pen entry.**
17. All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor, or have been in foster care of the exhibitor for at least 90 days prior to day of showing, proven by certificate showing Proof of Ownership, or Proof of Foster Care by Exhibitor affidavit, with appropriate signatures releasing the care of the animal and continuing supervision for the duration of project by both owner of animal and 4-H/FFA Club leader. Any meat pen project must have exhibitor in possession of brood animal at least 100 days prior to day of showing. **It is up to each individual exhibitor to locate or breed their own meat pen rabbits. The Manatee County Fair does not provide rabbits for exhibitors or give refunds if you were unable to locate rabbits.**
18. **Each exhibitor will be limited to a maximum of one (1) Show/Showmanship rabbit entry per person,** 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. One entry is either one buck or one doe. Exhibitors may also enter one meat pen entry (3 rabbits of same breed and variety) of any breed.
19. Manatee County Fair 2021 will have the Silent Auction held in the Powell Building for the sale of Meat Pens. If any exhibitor wishes to sell a steer or swine, they may also sell ONE

meat pen of EITHER poultry or rabbits. If any exhibitor does not have a steer or swine to raise and sell, they may sell ONE meat pen of BOTH poultry and rabbits. Each exhibitor must write a minimum of three (3) letters to prospective buyers for each meat pen intended for sale. Copies of these must be turned in with your record book at the final check-in.

Meat Pen Rabbit Sale Rules

The Rabbit pen sale will take place in the Stuart Rabbit barn this year. Bids will be taken from Wed., Jan. 13 through 8pm on Friday, Jan. 15. The exhibitor must be present at the rabbit barn Friday, January 15th in order to sell their meat pen. The exhibitor will present a thank you letter to their buyer. **Exhibitors must ensure meat is delivered to their buyer.** Failure to follow the above rules or the general rules of the Manatee River Fair Association Youth Livestock Show will result in disciplinary action up to expulsion from the barn, disqualification from the show, removal from the sale and possible loss of premiums or awards.

Fair premium money must be picked up within 90 days of the fair ending or it will be forfeited.

The Manatee River Fair Association will only handle add-on's totaling \$25.00 or more. Add-on's must be received by February 15, 2021. Add-On checks will be mailed after April 1, 2021 after each exhibitor's add-on monies are received by the fair office.

Exhibitor must submit verification to the fair office by July 1st with a signature from the buyer to obtain their sale checks.

Saleable animals including Steers, Swine, Beef Breeding, Dairy, Rabbit and Poultry Meat Pens will have six percent (6%) of each exhibitor's sale price and any add-ons deducted by the Fair Association to help defray expenses.

20. Meat Pens will be accepted at the Fair on Wednesday, January 13, 2021 4:00-5:30 pm. Auction bids will close at 8pm on Friday January 15, 2021. No does with litters, or pregnant does of more than (2) weeks will be accepted. Does showing signs of pregnancy will be palpated. All other show/showmanship check-in will occur between 4-5:30 pm on the respective day of Show/showmanship.
21. **Any individual rabbit or meat pen that is obviously a cross-breed which does not conform to a breed standard will not be accepted.**
22. **AT CHECK-IN, AND DURING FAIR, ANY ANIMAL FOUND TO BE ILL, DISEASED OR INSECT INFESTED WILL BE REMOVED AND SENT HOME IMMEDIATELY**

23. **Trophies will be presented for Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Best in Show Rabbit.**
1st Place in Showmanship for each age division of the Exhibitor – for Senior, Intermediate and Juniors. Rosettes will be presented to 2nd and 3rd place winners for Showmanship for each age division of the Exhibitors – for Senior, Intermediate and Juniors. A trophy will be presented for the Best Meat Pen.
24. The following classes will apply to the Rabbit Show:
- CLASS 4 – Senior Buck (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 6 months or older)
 - CLASS 4 – Senior Doe (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 6 months or older)
 - CLASS 4 – Junior Buck (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 6 months or younger)
 - CLASS 4 – Junior Doe (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 6 months or younger)

 - CLASS 6 – Senior Buck (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 8 months or older)
 - CLASS 6 – Senior Doe (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 8 months or older)
 - CLASS 6 – Intermediate Buck (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 6-8 months)
 - CLASS 6 – Intermediate Doe (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 6-8 months)
 - CLASS 6 – Junior Buck (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 6 months or younger)
 - CLASS 6 – Junior Doe (age of rabbit DAY OF SHOW – 6 months or younger)
25. We will have a **Rabbit Show and Showmanship events** with Covid-19 restrictions in place. Exhibitors must be 6 ft. apart and masks are worn at all times in the barn with the exception of showmanship presentations. Only one exhibitor at a time will be allowed at the rabbit judging table.
26. **Show and Showmanship**- These two events will be going on at the same time. Check in is between 4 to 5:30pm on your designated night. The events begin at 6:00pm. If you are not in the barn for your event, you will not be able to show.
27. Rabbit Showmanship will be shown in the following classes: (Age of Exhibitor on September 1, 2020) Senior 14-18 yrs., Intermediate 11-13 yrs., and Junior 8-10 yrs. Trophies will be presented for the 1st Place winner of each class, with rosettes being presented to 2nd and 3rd place winners for each age division of Exhibitors (Seniors, Intermediates & Juniors)
28. All 4-H and FFA member's Project Books must be up-to-date and presented at the time entries are checked-in at the Fair in order to qualify and any time upon request. On-line registration of animals will begin on Mon., October 5, 2020 through Wednesday, **October 26**, 2020.
29. The Livestock Committee reserves the right to refuse entry for health or appearance reasons if the entry does not comply with the rules and regulations of the Rabbit Show. **All rabbits will be judged on soundness, evidence of care, freedom from dirt, disease or parasites.** .

30. **Due to Covid-19 restrictions, the rabbit barn will house only exhibition/educational information and meat pen rabbits this year. Show Judging and Showmanship events for this year only will be a carry show. This means that exhibitors would only bring their rabbit to the fair on their designated date according to age groups. Check-in, show judging, and showmanship will occur on the same day.**
31. **Rabbits will enter the fairgrounds at Gate 1 on the corner of 17th St. and 14th Ave or walk in through gate 9. Vehicles blocking Gate 1 or 9 will be towed at the owner's expense. There will be no parking along the west end of the arena at any time! Violators will have their vehicles towed at the owner's expense.**
32. **The Manatee County Fair will not be responsible for loss by accidents, fire, theft, escape or providential destruction. All possible care will be taken in receiving, cooping, feeding, caring for and returning animals. The show committee reserves the right to reject any entry.**

Exhibitor and Parent Security Passes

Exhibitors will be given a **one** day pass to enter the fair for their Show/Showmanship class.

Exhibitors may choose to make a one-time purchase of a \$25 Security Entrance Pass that will give unlimited access to the fair for the entire run of the Fair. Families will be allowed to purchase (4) additional Security Entrance Passes at \$25 each which also gives unlimited access to the fair. Tickets are no longer given for fair entry.
