

## **Youth Livestock Show Ethics and Animal Care Workshop Revisions for 2020/2021 Fair Season**

1. Offer On-Site Workshops (where presenters feel comfortable holding and would be able to follow the CDC guidelines with social distancing) and Zoom Meeting Workshops (with limited attendance) for new exhibitors or anyone who needed to renew.
2. Extend the expiration date for the 2018 certifications until May 2021. For the 2020/2021 Fair Season – Certification Numbers starting with **18, 19, 20 or 21** are **current and valid**. (For example: 18FSF3001, 19FSF0001, 20FSF1111, 21FSF2222)

\*This would allow those exhibitors to wait a year to renew. There are 2700 exhibitors in the database with 2018 numbers. This would decrease the number of exhibitors who need to be renewed for 2021. In 2020, we had almost 3000 exhibitors who went thru the ethics program.

**All workshops will be posted on the Florida State Fair website and presenters would still need to contact the Agribusiness Office with the details for the workshops.**

### **On-Site Workshops**

- For On-Site Workshops, we will need the name of the location, address of location, size of class, time, etc.
- On-Site Workshops will be handled just like before – the presenter will be sent the sign-in sheets and list of attendees. It is the responsibility of the presenter to get the signed documents back to the FSF Office. Certification numbers will be issued and emailed once these documents are received.

### **Zoom Meeting Workshops**

- For the Zoom Meeting Workshops, we will need to know the day and time you would like to schedule. Please have some additional options in mind since these meetings will not be able to overlap.
- Zoom meeting workshops will also be posted on the Florida State Fair website in the same process. The Florida State Fair would set up each meeting to record and monitor attendance. Zoom Meeting workshops will be limited on number of participants (number to be determined – we are thinking no more than 25 students)
- Exhibitors will sign up for the workshop thru the Google Form – just like the On-Site workshops. It is a first-come, first-serve process.

- Exhibitors will receive the link to the workshop. Only students who have registered for the workshop will be allowed to attend. No additional exhibitors will be allowed and the link cannot be shared. Families with multiple students attending would need to register each exhibitor separately, and they could watch together on computer.
- Once the meeting starts, the student must keep the video component open so each student can be seen listening to the presentation. Any video components not open (where the student can be seen) will not be issued a number.
- The FSF Staff will set up each meeting to record the session and take attendance.
- The presenter will be given total access to the PowerPoint presentation. The presenter will be running the meeting!!!

**All certification numbers will be emailed to the exhibitor like we did last year. This process was much easier and allowed exhibitors to keep their letter on their own computer.**

**The FSF Agribusiness Office will create a flyer explaining these new procedures for exhibitors that will be posted on the FSF website, Facebook, Instagram and emailed to all 2019 & 2020 Youth Exhibitors. Sharing this flyer would be greatly appreciated so we can get the word out to any livestock exhibitor.**

### **Moving forward**

**Week of June 22<sup>nd</sup> – schedule the 1st Zoom Training with Karen Hamilton as the presenter with a small group of students as a test run**

**July 1<sup>st</sup> – begin scheduling classes thru Zoom and On-Site for all presenters**
