Poultry Rules:

1. The exhibitor must own any poultry, waterfowl or gamebirds exhibited at least two (2) months prior to the show.
2. They will remain on exhibit until fair closing on Saturday, February 22, 2020 at 11:00pm. Animals must be transported in an appropriate, washable carrier. *Please see rule #50, page 47*
3. Judging will be at 3:00pm on Saturday, February 13, 2021 in the small animal tent. Each exhibitor must be present to receive premiums.
4. The superintendent may refuse any poultry that they feel are unhealthy. Only healthy animals in good condition are accepted. (See state requirements)
5. All poultry are judged based on the Danish System. They are classed as either Bantams or Standards.
6. All barn and exhibitor rules apply to small animal exhibitors.
7. Each exhibitor is limited to five (5) total entries.

8. Poultry awards will be made as follows:

NOTE: Exhibitors must provide appropriate ground cages for large poultry, exotics, and waterfowl entries. *Anyone wishing to exhibit other small farm animals or exotics – as an Exhibition ONLY - should contact the fair office. Exhibitor must provide appropriate cages for these exhibits.*

** Exhibitors will be judged several times each day by a Livestock Committee Member on the appearance of your poultry's surrounding area. All feces should be removed promptly, and shavings replaced. You should act courteous to others and to the public. The Herdsman Award is based on how well you present your area, your poultry project and your conduct during the fair.
