



MONTGOMERY COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION MONTHLY SCRAMBLE REPORT

If the purchase price of the animal is more than the value of the certificate, the extra amount paid should be included as an expense. If it is necessary to have a nurse cow, her purchase price should not be included as an expense because you will be able to use her for several projects and perhaps sell her when you have completed your projects. No charge should be made for the milk the calf consumes. Grain and hay fed to either the calf or the nurse cow should be charged at the prevailing rate. Native pasture should be charged at the rate of \$2.00 per month and planted pasture at the rate of \$3.00 per month. No charge should be made for labor.
