



2021 Freshman Scholarship Guidelines

The following scholarships shall be awarded to applicants selected by NILE:

- One-time scholarships in the amount of \$1,000
- Shining Star One-time scholarship given to an outstanding Freshman applicant in the amount of \$2,000
- \$500 NILE Legacy Award - *open to freshman or secondary applicants*
- Rolling scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 awarded annually**

**These rolling scholarships are renewable for up to 4 years, for a total scholarship of \$4,000 as long as recipient remains in good standing and adheres to additional requirements.

Applicant Qualifications

1. Must have participated in NILE activities and be currently enrolled in a 4-H or FFA program
2. Minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) 2.5 or equivalent
3. Must be a graduating high school senior planning to attend a two or four-year college, university or vocational school in the academic year 2021-2022.
4. Be continually enrolled as a full-time student at their school of choice

Payment of Scholarships

Scholarship awards will be mailed directly to the college for application to tuition and fees in the school year 2021-2022. Scholarship recipients must submit a completed "Scholarship Acceptance Form" which will be mailed to recipient with letter of scholarship award. This form must be returned to the NILE Foundation office no later than **July 1, 2021**.

Scholarships not accepted by that date will be forfeited.

Application Deadline and Selection Process

1. The original application plus **10 copies** are due in the NILE Office no later than **March 2, 2021 by 4 p.m.** (postmarks of March 2nd will not be accepted).
2. Final selection of scholarship recipients will be made in early April 2021.

Application

The candidate must submit a properly completed official NILE scholarship application with the following components. Please include **10 copies with original application**.

1. Two separate letters of reference from teachers, ministers, employers or other persons well acquainted with, but not related to, the applicant.
2. A certified transcript of grades (current to time of application) from applicant's high school, which includes class rank.
3. One recent head and shoulders photo of the applicant for publication purposes. ***Graduation or senior picture is ideal.*** (Polaroid, other instant prints, or photos printed on printer paper are ***not*** acceptable.) Photo may be color or black and white. Photo must be high quality. Please identify name of applicant on back of photo. Photo will not be returned. One original photo will suffice. You may also email photo to shelby@thenile.org with applicants name in subject line.



Selection of the scholarship recipients is based on NILE participation, academic achievement, community involvement and need. Evaluation of scholarship applications and subsequent ranking of applicants shall be the sole responsibility of a designated NILE committee. Neatness in preparation of the application shall be considered. **Application folders or covers are NOT encouraged.**

Additional Requirements for Recipients of Rolling Scholarships

The NILE Scholarship Committee will select recipients of the Rolling Scholarships from the pool of the 2021 applicants. Each year recipients must remain in good standing as outlined in requirements listed below. Recipients must:

- Maintain a GPA of 3.0 to continue in the program
- Be continually enrolled as a full-time student
- Maintain involvement with NILE
- Be actively involved in college or university organizations and activities, preferably related to agriculture

To obtain scholarship award in future years, after 2021-2022 academic year, recipients must return the following items to the NILE Foundation office by March 1st of the current year. **Items not received by that date will be forfeited.**

1. Scholarship Renewal Form
2. Current Official Transcript
3. Statement of use of scholarship including how funds were utilized and what impact was made. Please limit to 500 words.
4. Statement of current involvement in NILE.
5. Statement of involvement in activities and organizations while attending college. Please limit to 500 words.

Additional Requirements:

- Scholarship recipients selected will be asked to attend a scholarship fundraiser for the NILE Foundation to be held mid-late summer 2021 in Billings, MT (*date and location TBD*).
- Signatures acknowledging the Application Statements from applicant, parent, & principal in addition to signed Media Release. Unsigned releases will not be considered for a scholarship.



Recipients of these scholarships will be notified in April 2021. Funds for the scholarship will be handled through the NILE Office and will be sent directly to the college or university that the recipient will attend. It is imperative that recipients notify NILE of acceptance by their chosen college or university and meet the requirements specified in the NILE scholarship policies.
