Tickets on Sale for “A Night In Old San Antonio®” (NIOA®)

New this year: e-tickets from NIOA website

“A Night In Old San Antonio®” (NIOA®) is a four-night festival in the heart of downtown San Antonio that celebrates the city’s diverse cultural legacy for more than 80,000 revelers annually. Through the magic of more than 200 food, drink and atmosphere booths; 14 live musical acts; children’s games; decorations; costumed volunteers; and souvenirs, NIOA brings the city’s heritage alive in 15 areas (Arneson Theatre, China Town, Clown Alley, French Quarter, Froggy Bottom, Frontier Town, Haymarket, International Walkway, Irish Flats, Main Street USA, Mexican Market, Mission Trail, Sauerkraut Bend, South of the Border and Villa España).

Sponsored by and benefiting the San Antonio Conservation Society, the 69th presentation of NIOA will be held April 25-28, 2017, during the city’s [Fiesta San Antonio®](#) celebration.

NIOA discount tickets are available March 1 through April 28 for \$12 on NIOA website or at [NIOA Crafters Store](#) in La Villita; H-E-B grocery stores in San Antonio, Boerne, Bulverde, Seguin and New Braunfels; USAA; Fiesta Store; Southwest Research; Ft. Sam Houston; Lackland AFB and Randolph AFB. Some sellers add service charge. Children 12 and under are free with paying adult.

NEW THIS YEAR: Download discount e-tickets from NIOA website to your phone or tablet, or print out. All NIOA gates will have separate lines for e-ticket users.

Tickets can be purchased nightly during NIOA at the gates for \$15 for adults; children 12 and under are free when accompanied by an adult. Gates open at 5:30 p.m. and close at 10 p.m.; food sales and entertainment continue until 10:30 p.m. All tickets are non-refundable; NIOA is open, rain or shine. Strollers and backpacks are not allowed.

NIOA is held on the five-acre grounds of the [La Villita](#) National Historic District—the 18th century Spanish neighborhood, bounded by the San Antonio River and Alamo, Nueva and Presa streets. Funds raised enable the Society to continue its mission of preserving historic buildings, objects, places and customs relating to the history of Texas and all that is admirably distinctive to the state.
