NIOSITA VOLUNTEER INDEMNITY AND HOLD HARMLESS

In consideration of being accepted as a Volunteer, each Volunteer agrees to the following prior to the start of their volunteer assignment:

The San Antonio Conservation Society shall not be liable or responsible to the Volunteer or any other person, and is released and discharged for any damages or injuries whatsoever suffered by the Volunteer in connection with any work or other activities performed at NIOSA/NIOSITA EVENTS; furthermore, any damages caused by the Volunteer shall be the sole responsibility of the Volunteer AND THE VOLUNTEER SHALL EXPRESSLY INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS AND DEFEND THE SAN ANTONIO CONSERVATION SOCIETY FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL RESULTING CLAIMS, ACTIONS OR DAMAGES OF WHATEVER NATURE CAUSED BY THE VOLUNTEER. THIS HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT IS GOOD FOR ANY WORK AND ACTIVITIES WITHIN ONE YEAR OF THE DATE SIGNED.

ALCOHOL BOOTH VOLUNTEER POLICIES

If you are assigned to serve as an alcohol booth volunteer, you are required to subscribe to the following NIOSA policies and adhere to the Texas State Laws:

- All Servers at NIOSA/NIOSITA Events must be TABC certified.
- Patrons may receive only two (2) servings of an alcoholic beverage per time in line.
- Do not re-fill cups. No smoking, eating or drinking in booth area.
- Individuals under the age of 21 will not be served an alcoholic beverage. (Serving an alcoholic beverage to a minor is a "Class A" misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$4,000, confinement in jail for a term not to exceed one year, or both.)
- Any patron appearing to be intoxicated will not be served additional alcoholic beverages. Knowingly serving alcoholic beverages to an intoxicated person is a "Class A" misdemeanor.
- If you have any questions about an individual's age or level of intoxication, please ask for assistance. Please Say 'No' If You Are Not Sure.
- If you serve alcohol to a minor (under the age of 21) or to an intoxicated person, YOU ARE LIABLE.

I, the undersigned, understand and agree to the Indemnity and Hold Harmless terms stated above. I also understand that I may be held personally liable should I not follow the NIOSA Alcohol guidelines and Texas State Laws.
