# VIRTUAL SHOW RULES

1. All entries must be turned in online. No exceptions. All requirements are detailed on online registration.
2. Maximum of 2 (TWO) Still life entries per exhibitor, per division. Maximum of 3 (THREE) Livestock entries per exhibitor, per division. With a Maximum of 10 (TEN) entries per Exhibitor.
3. The exhibitor must be a Washington State Resident.
4. By entering this competition, the Exhibitor undertake that the exhibit is shown in its current condition. Photos and videos MUST NOT be taken before June 1, 2020. Where an exhibit is an animal, the exhibit must be alive and in the hands of occupancy of the exhibitor on the date of entry submission.
5. By entering this competition, the Exhibitor undertake that the media used for the entry is a true representation of the condition of the exhibit and has not been enhanced or altered in any way.
6. By entering this competition, the Exhibitor undertake that the content submitted for entry can be used by The Northwest Washington Fair for promotional media and educational material.
7. Virtual Ribbons only will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd Places, honorable mentions may be awarded at the discretion of the judging panel.
8. ALL exhibits maybe displayed on the Northwest Washington Fair Facebook page by the Show Stewards. Judging results and comments will also be displayed. Winning entries will be acknowledged at the completion of the Online Show and winning exhibitors identified in Facebook posts.
9. The exhibitor and exhibit photos may be SHARED on Northwest Washington Fair Facebook page as part of the competition advertising campaign.
10. Any entry maybe featured in the Online Show Grand Parade.
11. If an exhibitor wishes to enter the exhibit in a future online show, a complete set of new photos and/or videos must be used.
12. In any class containing more than 6 (SIX) exhibits of the same breed, sub-classes may be created at the discretion of the Show Stewards.
13. Always remember, the soul objective of this event is to provide a friendly competition that celebrates exhibition and encourages participation in agricultural shows.
14. The judging panel's decision is FINAL, and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. **PREMIUMS ARE SPONSORED BY Phillips 66 of Ferndale. Premium amounts will be awarded depending on number of entries we receive.**
16. The Participant acknowledges that due to the nature of the activities required in support of an online entry, it would be unreasonable for the Group to be in any way responsible for any injury to or death of the Participant. The Participant hereby, waives all of his or her legal rights of action against the Group and fully releases the Group, to the extent allowable under the law, for any personal injury or death arising out or in relation to the Participant undertaking the activities including without limitation, liability for any negligent or tortious act or omission, breach of duty, breach of contract or breach of statutory duty on the part of the Group, its office bearers, directors, employees or agents.



# 4-H DIVISION RULES



1. Must be a current 4-H member by June 1, 2020
2. Youth who have reached their 5th birthday (on or before October 1st of the current 4-H year), through those who have not reached their 19th birthday (on or before October 1st of the current 4-H year).
3. The following groups are identified for special programs and activity participation, including all competitive events/activities, within the WSU Extension 4-H Youth Development Program:

AGE IS DETERMINED BY OCTOBER 1 of previous year.

- Cloverbuds: 5 to 7 years of age
  - Junior: 8 to 10 years of age
  - Intermediate: 11 to 13 years of age
  - Senior: 14 to less than 19 years of age
  - Cloverbuds may participate in age-appropriate activities and projects. Projects recommended for Cloverbuds youth may include: Dog, Cat, Poultry, Rabbit, Pygmy or Novelty Goat, Horseless Horse, Cavy, Exploring the World of Small Animals, Exploring Farm Animals, Discovery, Creative Arts, Performing Arts, Aerospace, Bicycle, Computer, Photography, Clothing, Just Outside the Door, and Exploring 4-H. Cloverbuds may not participate in competitive activities. 4-H Cloverbuds are not eligible for premiums and must borrow a goat and does not need to preregister for the Primary Showmanship contest. Primary Showman may not bring their own goat to the fair.
4. A novelty goat is defined as a small goat that is purebred or cross-bred lineage; is up to 23 inches in height and weighs no more than 65 pounds.
  5. Only blue and red ribbon winners in 4H and FFA Beef or Dairy Cattle are eligible to enter Open Class Beef and Dairy classes.
  6. 4H and FFA may enter Open Class Dairy Cattle or Beef Cattle provided there is a minimum of 10 Open Class cattle per breed or 2 exhibitors.
  7. All 4-H Exhibitors must exhibit 4-H Showmanship in each livestock division they enter in order to exhibit any type animal classes.
